





- Text: Times New Roman, font size 10, normal, margin 1 inch all sides.
- Key words: Times New Roman, font size 10, normal, bold.
- Abstracts of maximum 250 words are invited on the above themes. The soft copy of abstract should be sent to chintan@sinhgad.edu
- Paper should include Introduction, Background of study / theoretic background, Objective, Hypothesis, Research Methodology, Primary Data and Secondary Data, Data Analysis, Findings, Conclusion and Limitations, except for thematic articles.
