Memorandum of Understanding

1. Purpose

The purpose is to create a partnership between ECTA, P.O. Box 3450, Kigali, Rwanda, which is registered in Rwanda, Trade License Code number 100461576, and SINHGAD TECHNICAL EDUCATION SOCIETY, 44/1, VADGAON BK, PUNE - 41, MAHARASHTRA, INDIA.

ECTA which is specialized in Construction and Architecture want participate to the development of Rwanda through an Educational Institute in Technology with good quality of teaching with international level in order to promote Industries in Rwanda, created jobs and maintain the quality of work, ECTA propose to STES which has rich experience in education field, to be a partner in this project.

2. Program Description

a) ECTA is going to prepare all required for an Educational Institution according to Rwandan bylaws and infrastructures to accommodate the institute as standard required as guided by STES.

b) Sinhgad STES is interested to work with ECTA in this project and is going to provide teachers according to international level and in respect of Rwandans bylaws without any income from the project only the institute will provide transport, accommodation and salaries to the Director, Teacher Tech. Assistant, and other supporting staff from India according to Indian or Rwandan salaries.

c) Once all preparation with respect to Infrastructure, Lab, classroom, workshop, library are ready then STES will immediately send the requested teaching and non teaching faculty.

3. Operating Procedure

a) The educational institute will have her own management system but if required Sinhgad Will come as a consultant for supervision and execution of the institute and if STES doesn't have qualified teachers in any course, the institute will negotiate with others Educational institution.

b) STES accepts to give all information's required for the preparation for program, library, equipment and others for starting the Institute.

c) STES accept in order to prepare future Rwandese teachers, to train students recommended by ECTA in India with same cost as a local.

ECTA and STES are liable in order to maintain the quality of education for that ECTA will represent, STES in Rwanda and shall avoid others African Countries in order to avoid conflicts.

5. Use of Confidential Information

The parties understand the importance of the protection of intellectual property. The parties agree to:

(a) Receive and maintain the confidential information in confidence;

(b) Not reproduce the confidential information or any part thereof without the express written consent of disclosing party;

(c) Not, directly or indirectly, make known, divulge, publish or communicate the confidential information to any person, firm or corporation without the express written consent of disclosing party;
(d) limit the internal dissemination of the confidential information and the internal disclosure of the

confidential information received from the disclosing party to those officers and employees, if any, of

the receiving party who have a need to know and an obligation to protect it;

- (e) Not use or utilize the confidential information without the express written consent of disclosing party;
- (f) not use the confidential information or any part there of as a basis for the design or creation of any method, system, apparatus or device similar to any method, system, apparatus or device embodied in the confidential information unless expressly authorized in writing by disclosing party;
- (g) Utilize the best efforts possible to protect and safeguard the confidential information from loss, theft, destruction, or the like.
- (h)All information provided by the disclosing party shall remain the property of the disclosing party.

6. Dispute resolution

The parties agree to try to resolve policy or practice disputes at the lowest level possible. If issues cannot be resolved at this level, a third party may be called in to help mediate any dispute. Informal mediation services, however, shall be explored prior to any other formal or legal process. Each party agrees to be responsible for its own financial obligation in this matter.

7. Duration and Modification of the MOU

Initial period of MOU shall be binding in both parties for 5 years. The parties understand that implementation of the MOU is dependent on both parties working together in good faith. The partners agree that the terms of the MOU will take effect upon signature of both parties when project start and will continue in effect as long as the parties choose to work together.

Termination of the MOU will be effective in either of two situations:

- 1. All partners agree in writing to its termination; or
- 2. One of the parties receives written notification of termination from the other party. In the event that it becomes necessary for one party to cease being a party to this MOU that said party shall notify the other party, in writing, ninety (90) days in advance of that intention. However, Sinhgad cannot terminate the MOU during an ongoing project before one course degree to avoiding a void in education.

This MOU may be reviewed and renewed annually and modified, altered, or revised, as necessary, by mutual consent of both parties, through the issuance of a written amendment, signed and dated by all parties

Each party enters into this Agreement in a spirit of cooperation and collaboration, for the purposes described above.

Memorandum of Understanding

Summer Internship Programme

In order to promote academic perfection, project/problem oriented study, research and educational exchanges at International level for the multifaceted development of students, the two institutions agree to formalize a MoU as follows:

Within arenas that are mutually suitable and acceptable, the following general forms of support will be followed:

- · Academics and Courses:
 - o Planning and handling of courses to promote cross cultural education.
 - Organization of seminars/ workshops to gain practical and international exposure by sharing experiences, and teaching.
 - Explore possibilities of recent interdisciplinary areas of specialization of high relevance to institutions such as the areas of Problem Based Learning (PBL), Security, Privacy, Cloud Computing, Internet of Things (IoT), and Business models.
- Establishing strong business relationships between both parties.
- · Students Internships Terms:
 - o The Internship programme details are made available to the graduate students. Interested students can apply for projects / Courses of their choice and can prepare well for a rigorous selection procedure.
 - Selected student for internship program will be subject to the admission requirements, tuition fees & accommodation fees of the CMI, Aalborg University.
 - o The student internship program will run with the minimum of 20 students and the maximum of 30 students per duration. Any variation in the number of students needs to be agreed by both the parties.

- The period of Internship in Nov/Dec will be around 3 weeks and for summer intake it can possibly be 4 weeks.
- o The CMI should provide training/technical guidance to the students. CMI will organize the activities as a domain specific course of 5 ECTS. Groups of students will study recent issue/problems under CMI appointed supervisor.
- Internship completion certificate will be issued to the students by the CMI, Aalborg University.

Financial Terms:

- This MoU imposes financial obligations allied with knowledge transfer, conduction of sessions for students, accommodation, food and travels.
- For each intern, financial requirements were agreed for a period of 3 to 4 weeks and these are:
 - Internship Fee (Session, Course, etc): 6500 DKK
 - STES will be financially responsible for Accommodation,
 Food, Travels including local transportation and CMI will assist with local arrangements.
 - STES will be a common window to deal with financial obligations.

The CMI will evaluate the students and determine their acceptability for admission as intern student. The CMI reserves the right to reject the home university's nominated students. The home university may appeal the rejection.

This MoU will become effective on the final date of signing and will have duration of five years. This MoU may be terminated by either party by giving prior twelve months written notice, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon.

Both Parties agrees that all information and materials disclosed by the them regarding the proposed model, including the terms and conditions of this Agreement and the existence of the discussion between the them, will be considered and referred to collectively in this Agreement as "Confidential Information".

Each Party shall not disclose, publish, or otherwise disseminate Confidential information to anyone other than those of its employees and trusted subcontractors with a need to know, and shall take reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized use, disclosure, publication, or dissemination of Confidential Information.
