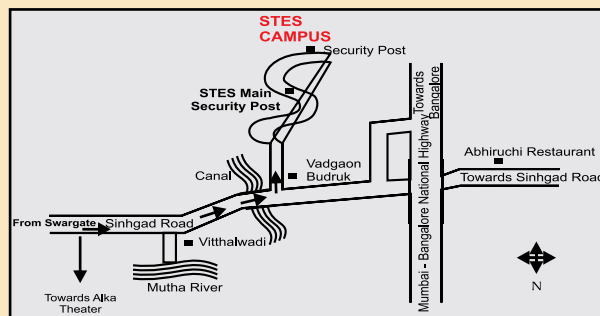

About the Organization

Sinhgad Technical Education Society has been established under the dynamic leadership of Prof. M. N.
