Background and Objective of seminar:

Traditionally natural products have played an important role in drug discovery, in the past few years most Big Pharma companies have either terminated or considerably scaled down their natural product operations. Recently, there has been a renewed interest in natural product research due to the failure of alternative drug discovery methods to deliver many lead compounds in key therapeutic areas such as immune-suppression, anti-infectives, and metabolic diseases.

The study of natural products offers an excellent strategy toward identifying novel biological probes for a number of diseases. Research in natural products encompasses the exploration of biodiversity for novel drug lead discovery, isolation and structure determination of organic natural products of medicinal significance from plants and microbes, studies on the structure and biochemistry of biological products, examination of the biosynthesis of natural products, and evaluation of the biochemical effects of these active constituents.
