

- The font size should be Times New Roman 12 point with single spacing.
- The abstract should be preceded by a separate page with the detailed information (Name, affiliation, email ID, contact number) of the author. In case of multiple authors, the first author's email ID will be considered for communication unless otherwise specified.

GUIDELINES FOR SEMINAR PAPERS SUBMISSION:

- Papers must not exceed 2000 to 3000 words in length, including abstract, figures and references or it must not be longer than ten pages.
- Tables and figures must have a number and title, and must appear in the paper as per their reference in the text.
- The paper must be typed in Word format in Times New Roman font with font size 12 and single spacing.
- Put the title of the paper in bold at the top of the first page only along with author details.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

You will need to prepare some PowerPoint slides to support your presentation. The presentation will be around 15 minutes, with 5 minutes allowed for discussion.
