A neurological disorder is any disorder of the body nervous system leading to Structural, biochemical or electrical abnormalities in the brain, spinal cord or other nerves. One can witness the increasing global public health importance of common neurological disorders such as dementia, epilepsy, headache disorders, multiple sclerosis, neuroinfections, neurological disorders associated with malnutrition, pain associated with neurological disorders, Parkinson's disease, stroke and traumatic brain injuries. There are various approaches available to treat them. Therapeutic potentials of herbal drug ranges from part of plants, through simple extracts to isolated active constituents. There has been resurgence of interest on plants and plant derived products as a source of medicine in the last few decades. This is considered as one of the promising avenue for tackling the neurological disorders but not all.
