"Challenges in Separation by HPLC"



These diseases include hypertension, heart diseases, stroke, diabetes, cancer, obesity, diseases associated with smoking and alcohol (chronic bronchitis, premature mortality, etc). The disease profile of the world is changing rapidly, especially in developing countries. Approximately four out of five LSD deaths occurred in low and middle-income countries. While the global LSD burden is enormous, common risk factors are largely modifiable and therefore action can be taken to reduce the relevant morbidity and mortality. The present seminar would therefore focus on the causes; health related alarms required to be noticed at an early age, prevention and management of LSD and current research scenario.
