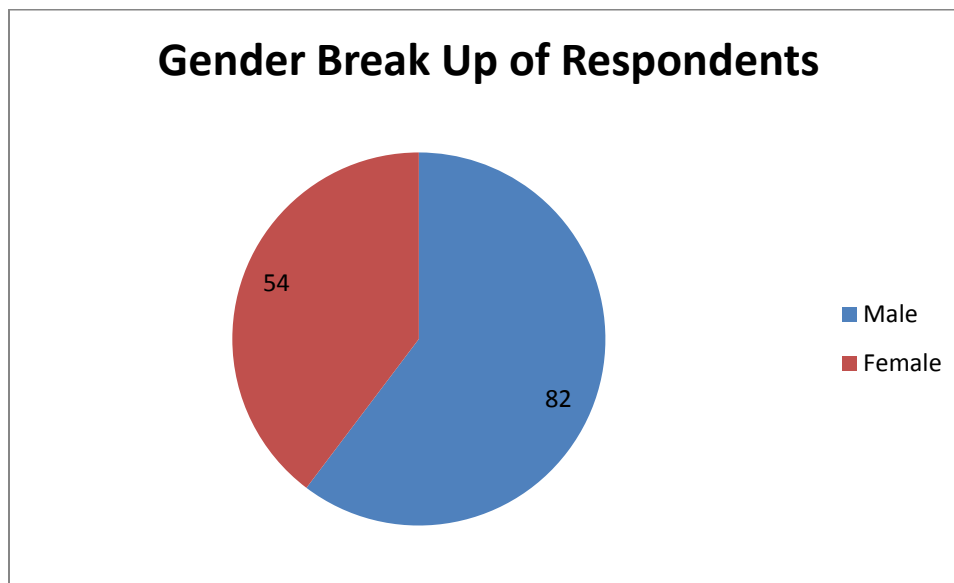

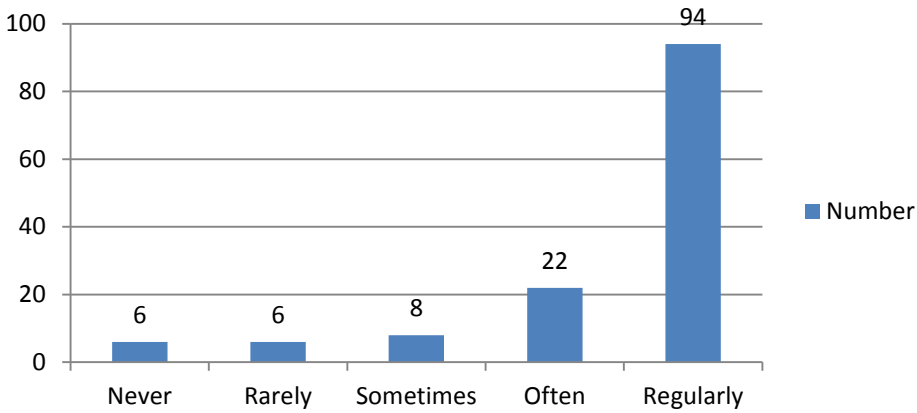
Gender wise breakup of the respondents:

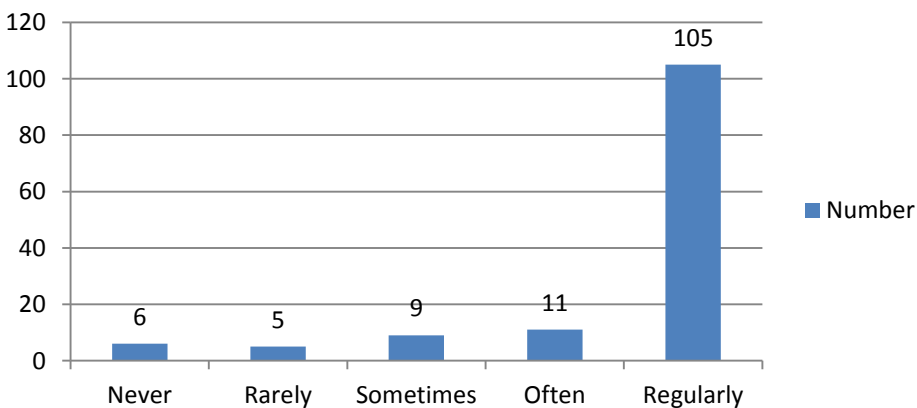
How Much Of The Syllabus Was Covered In The Class

How Much Of The Syllabus Was Covered In The Class

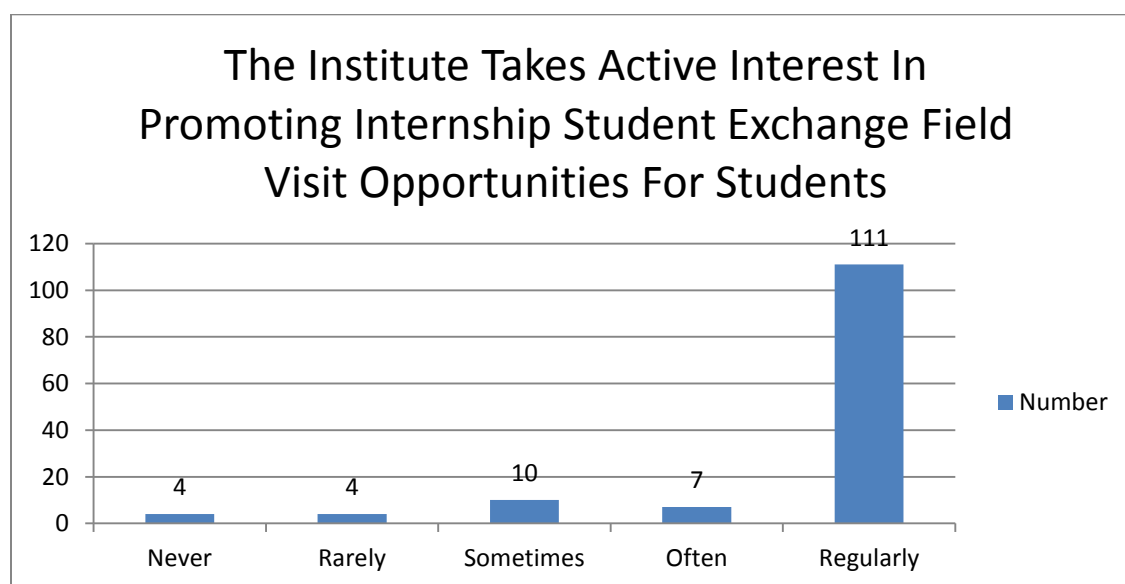

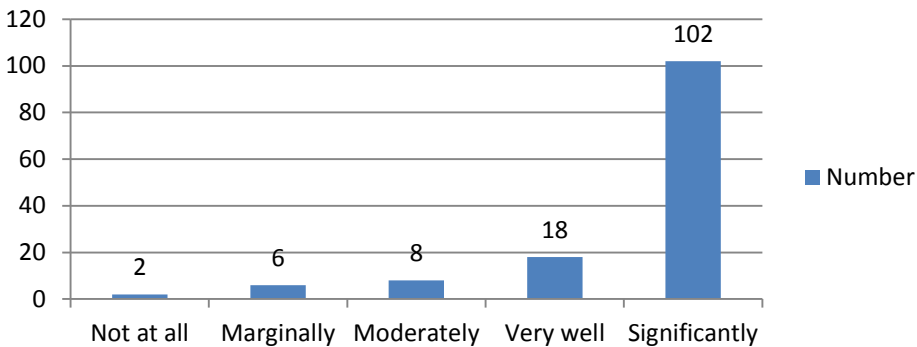

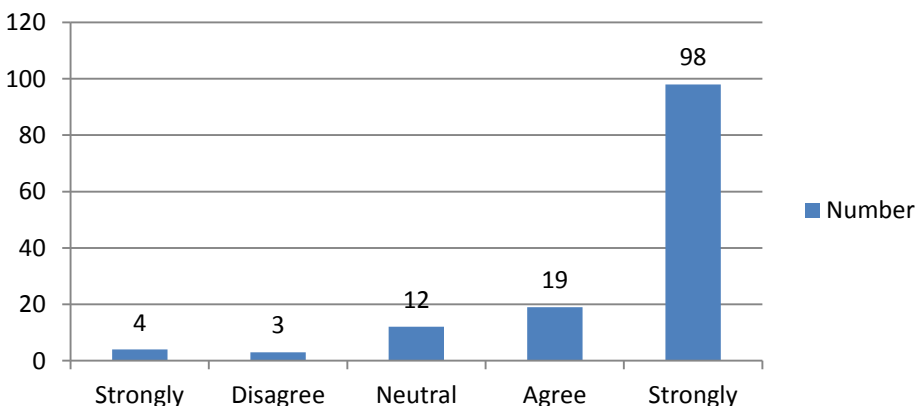

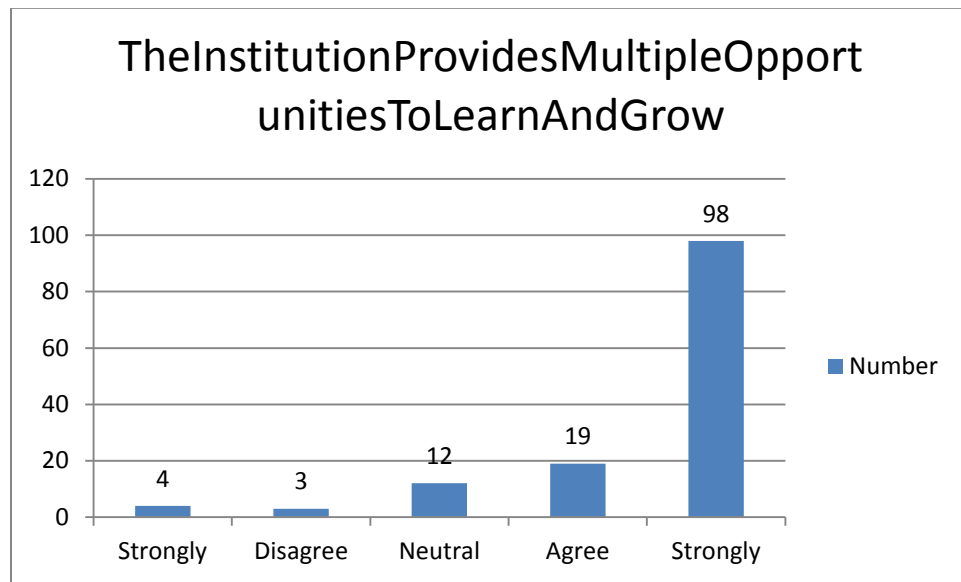

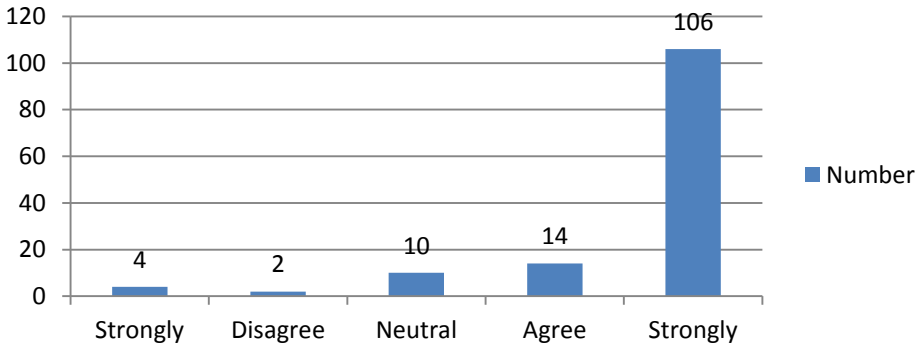

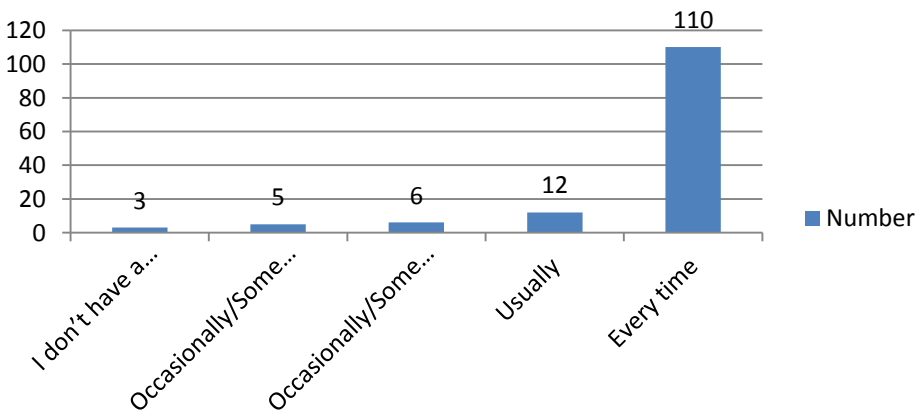

Teachers Inform You About Your Expected Competencies Course Outcomes And Programme Outcomes

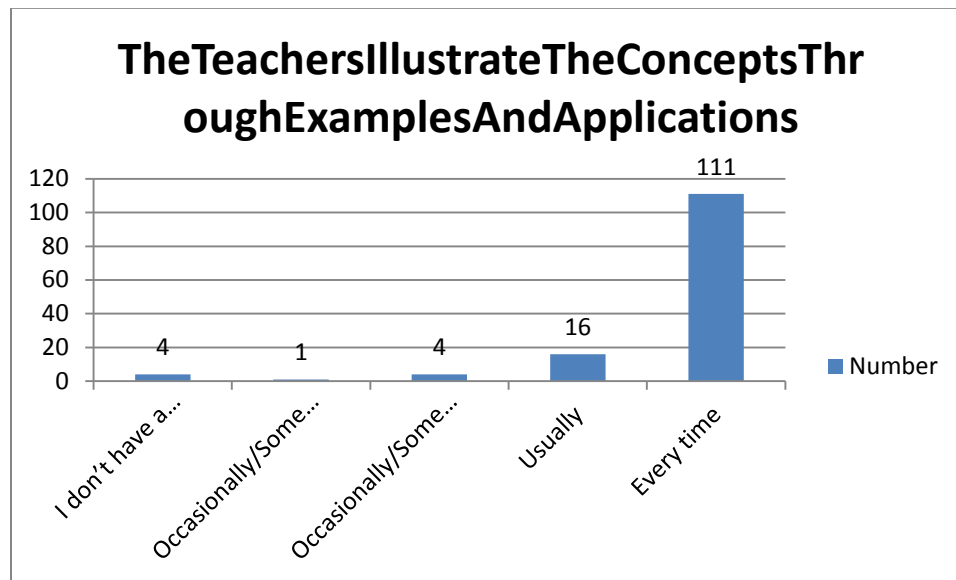

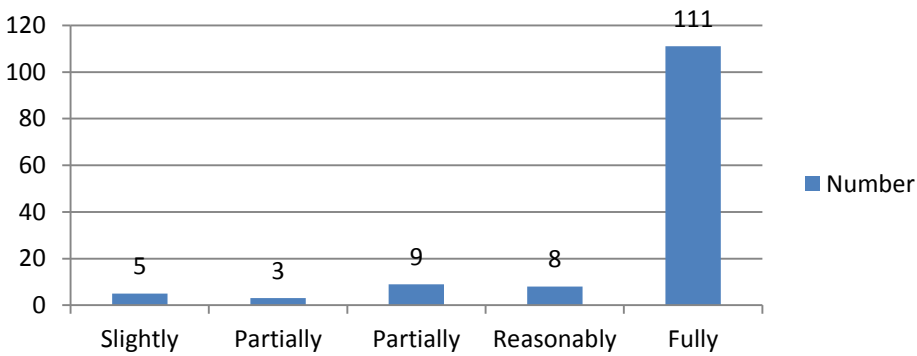

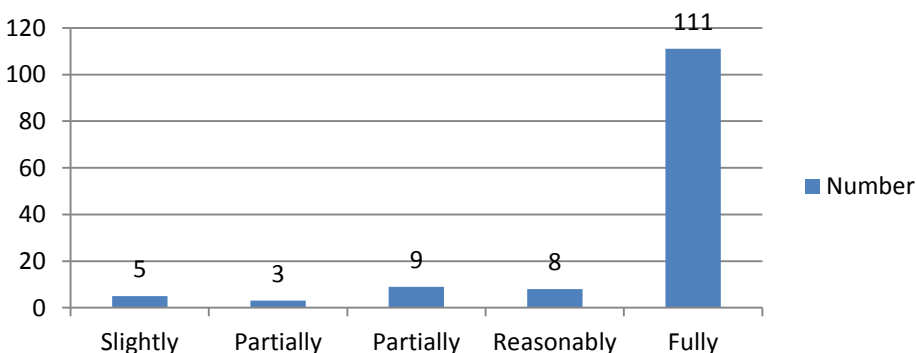

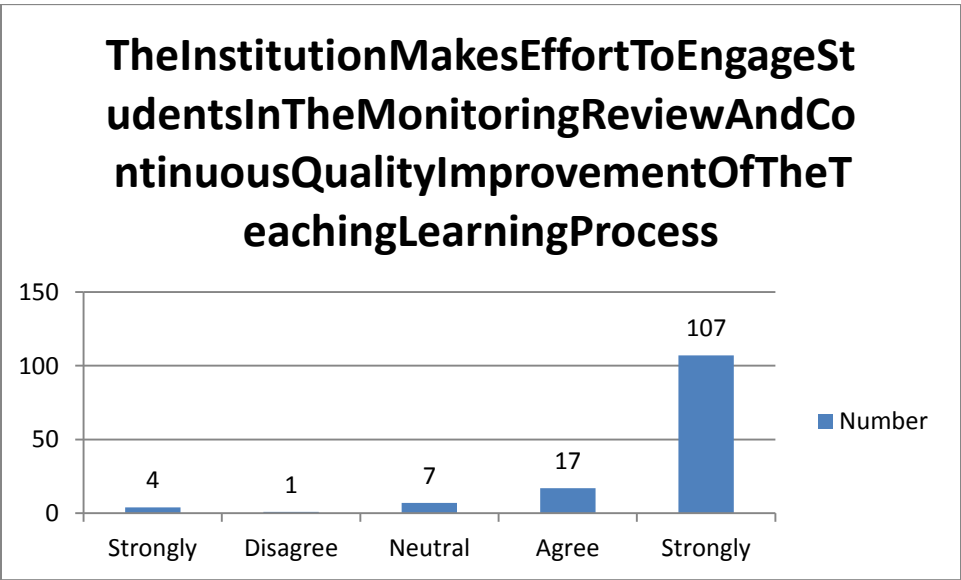

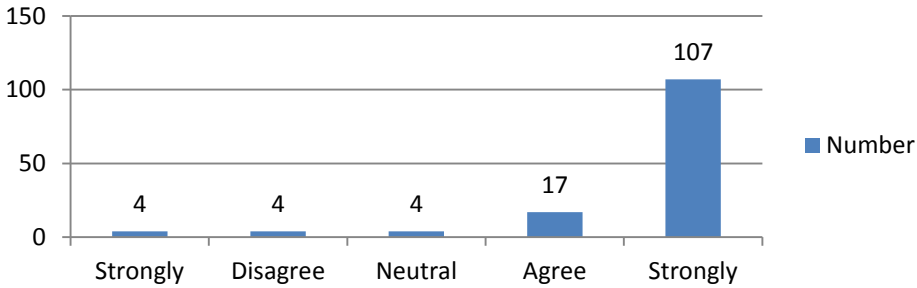

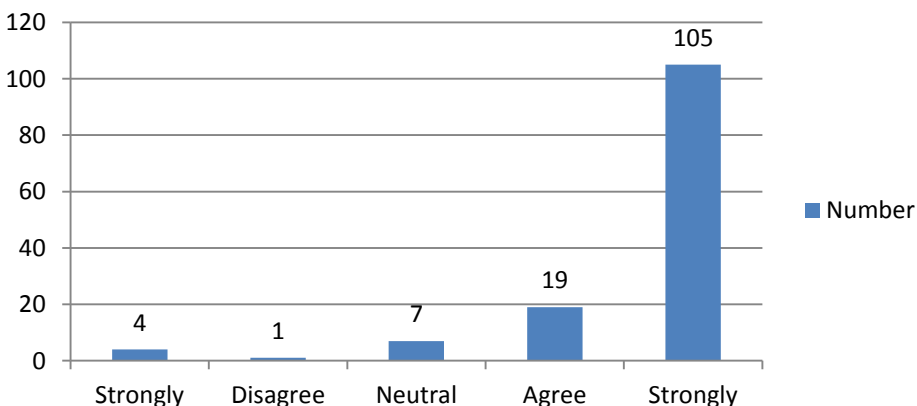

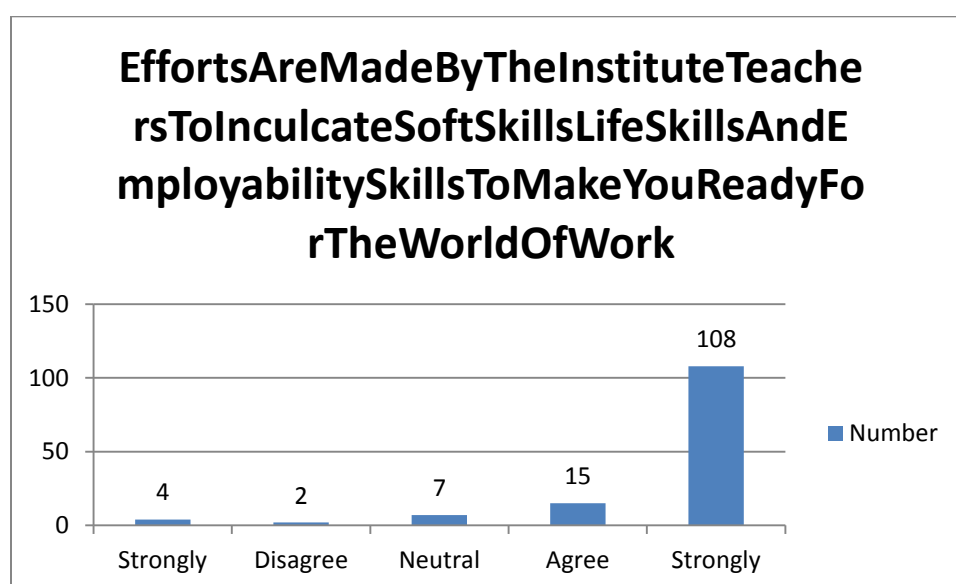

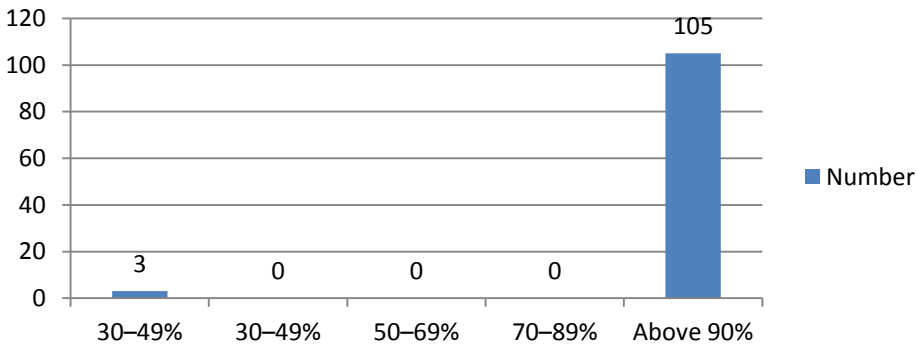

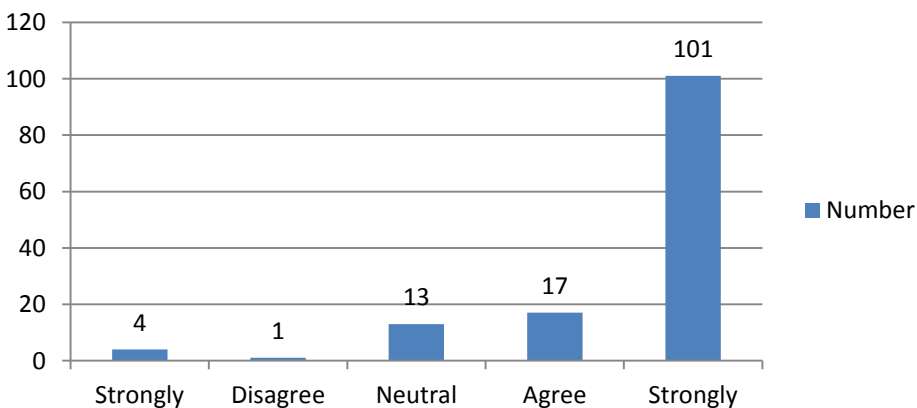
