

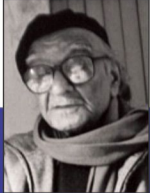

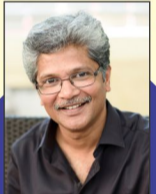
**Dr. Erach Bharucha**
