

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR PAPER-II, IN THE FACULTY OF MANAGEMENT, ON 8th December 2013

Paper-II Examination, as a part of PhD Admission process, for the Faculty of Management, is scheduled on 8th December 2013

1. Paper –II is of 3 hours, from 1100 hrs to 1400hrs.
2. Block wise seating arrangements will be put on the website of the concerned exam centre on Monday 2nd December, 2013, by 5.00 pm.
3. The candidates have already given the choices of the domain subjects while registering themselves for the selection process. The seating arrangement is as per the subject choice indicated by the candidate. **It may please be noted that no change will be allowed in the choice of subject.**
4. **Candidates who had applied in the domain subject –General Management will have to appear for paper in Organization Management & Economic Environment, as there is no separate subject of General Management.**

Before the start of exam:

Candidates should report to their respective centers at 10:30 am on 8th December 2013.

1. Those candidates who have appeared for PhD entrance exam Nov 2013 should carry their admit cards with photo ID with them. Admit card for paper I will be valid for paper –II also. No separate admit cards will be issued by Department of Management Sciences, (PUMBA), for paper-II.
2. The candidates who have qualified paper-I exam in Jan/Feb 2010 and Jan 2012 and now appearing for paper-II should also carry their admit cards with them.

3. In case of loss of admit card issued by the University, the student is required to carry any photo identity with photocopy of the photo ID and get it verified from the Centre Head, of the concerned centre on the exam day. Such students should report to the exam centre at 1000 hrs.

Writing the exam:

1. The candidates are required to read the instructions written on the question paper and follow the instructions meticulously.
2. For writing the Examination of paper-II, only one 16 page answer sheet will be provided. It may please be noted that no supplement answer copy will be given to any candidate.
3. Use only blue and black ball point pen to write answers.
4. Use of simple calculator only will be permitted.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to carry mobile phones inside the examination hall.
6. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall during the conduct of paper-II.

After writing the exam:

1. The candidate is required to return the following to the invigilators of the respective examination hall:
 - 1) the answer copy.
 - 2) the question paper booklet.
2. After receiving 'all clear' report from all the invigilators, the centre head will allow the candidates to leave the exam hall.
